Wow, what an incredible donation to help the animals of Butte County! I want you to know how much your generous donation means to the North Valley Animal Disaster Group!

The **North Valley Animal Disaster Group (NVADG)** was the first animal rescue group activated for the Camp Fire. Our volunteers worked thousands of hours providing evacuation, rescue, sheltering, and support during the fire response.

-Our phone operators and data entry personnel handled over 10,000 requests for service beginning on day one, and continuing today as owner-animal reunification takes place.

-The Evacuation Teams rescued over a thousand animals, and fed and watered animals behind the fire lines even after the evacuation orders were lifted.

-Our fabulous Shelter Teams provided excellent hands-on care for over 2000 animals in four different emergency animal shelters. *Big and small, we took care of them all!*

-NVADG just trained over 150 new volunteers at our annual two-day training, January 19th and 20th. We also completed our recurrent training for existing volunteers the following weekend. Our experienced instructors provide national and international training for other animal rescue groups every year. We will be ready for the next disaster.
